Borderline Personality Disorder

Common Traits/Behaviors

Alienation of others Catastrophizing

Always/Never statements Dependency/engulfment

Feelings of being wronged/invalidated Confirmation bias

Anger White hats/black hats (splitting)

Creating chaos/"drama" Impulsiveness

Self-isolation Testing people's loyalties
Self-centered behavior Passive-aggressive behavior

Munchausen-type behavior Projection

Age of Onset

Presents in teens-early adulthood

Impulsive behavior tends to decrease by around age 40

3:1 female to male

Causes - both genetic & environmental

5x more likely to be diagnosed if a 1st deg. Relative has BPD

Triggers incl.:

- -abuse (physical, emotional, sexual)
- -neglect/abandonment

DSM-V Criteria 1

Frantic efforts to avoid abandonment

DSM-V Criteria 2

Identity disturbance; unstable sense of self

DSM-V Criteria 3

Impulsivity in at least two self-damaging categories

- -sex
- -drugs
- -food
- -spending
- -driving...

DSM-V Criteria 4

Recurrent suicidal thoughts/behaviors/threats or self-harm

DSM-V Criteria 5

Mood instability (very reactive)

DSM-V Criteria 6

Chronic feelings of emptiness

DSM-V Criteria 7

Inappropriate, intense anger or difficulty controlling anger

DSM-V Criteria 8

Transient stress-related paranoid ideation (suspicious of others or feelings of being persecuted), or severe dissociative symptoms
